Types of Uploadable Images:

- **Basic Images**, also known as raster images, include .jpg, .bmp, .png, and .gif file types. These files are uploaded as a single layer, and you can edit the image during the upload process.
- Vector Images include .svg and .dxf files. These cut ready images that upload as designed. Files designed with layers will automatically be separated into layers after uploading and saving.

 Features to look for in basic images: Black & white or solid, contrasting colors Smooth, defined outlines Limited details High resolution, not grainy or pixely Avoid watermarked images Follow your design search terms with "silhouette," "high contrast," "outline," "logo," or "shape 	 Features to look for in vector images: Simple shapes and line art Clean, defined lines Limited unnecessary details or artifacts There are a few websites that provide free SVGs, but be cautious of ads, malware, and suspicious links when downloading from them.
